Below are the times and the areas we need volunteers. Setup Volunteers: 5-7 needed. 7AM-9AM (Will help vendors setup and will help setup the breakout room and event materials.)

- Morning Volunteers: Hand out bags to students, greeters, floaters to help wherever is needed 10 needed, 7AM-10AM
- Morning Breakout Volunteers: 16 needed (2 per student group)—these volunteers will help get the group of students from room to room, 8 (presenter volunteers and timers)—these volunteers will help the breakout presenters and keep time to make sure we keep on schedule, 9:15AM-11:45AM
- Afternoon Volunteers: 7 needed (will help with lunch) 11:15AM-1PM

- Clean-up volunteers: 10 (will help clean up and pack up everything following the event), 3PM-4:30PM

We will be scheduling a zoom volunteer orientation for 9/20 and 9/21 where we will go over what is needed from each volunteer and will answer any questions the volunteers may have.
