

Post a Job | Access Arizona's Tech Talent Pool

Post a job with ease and make the right hire! Strike the right balance between finding someone fast and finding someone great. Post a job with the Arizona Technology Council for a fraction of the cost.

Council members and non-member companies have the opportunity to have up to two job postings in the Council's weekly Monday morning eblast that's delivered to over 10,000 inboxes.

Gain added exposure via the Council's online job board: Council members may send a brief job description and a URL at no cost to marketing@aztechcouncil.org. Non-member companies are welcome to purchase the job-post package that works best for their needs as noted below.

Post a Job to Arizona's largest tech-talent network:

STEP 1: To purchase the options for job listings, **VISIT HERE**.

- 4 weeks via eblast for AZTC members: \$25 per job
- 4 weeks via eblast for non-members: \$50 per job
- 1 year via eblast for AZTC members: \$150 package (2 jobs per week)
- 1 year via eblast for non-members: \$300 package (2 jobs per week)
- 4 weeks via the Council's online job board for non-members: \$25 per job

STEP 2:

For job postings in the Council's weekly eblast, send the job title + URL to events@aztechcouncil.org. For the Council's online job board, send a brief description + URL to marketing@aztechcouncil.org.

In order for jobs to be included in the Monday morning email, jobs must be submitted 3 p.m. on Friday. All jobs submitted and paid by the Friday deadline will be posted in the Monday morning email.

FAQs

Can I change job postings week to week?

Yes. You can change job listings at any time by submitting the new job posting by the 3 p.m. deadline each Friday. If you purchase a four-week plan and want to change each week, you can.

How is the weekly email job postings different from the Council's job board?

Council members have the opportunity to post job openings at no cost to the Council's online job board. Non-members are welcome to submit openings to the Council's online job board for a small fee as noted above.
