- » At least one medical plan must be purchased along with the required \$25K of life insurance (less than \$3 per employee per month)
- » The company must be headquartered in Arizona

## Blue Cross Blue Shield of Arizona Medical Plan

- » Expansive menu of plan options
- » 4 networks - Statewide w/ Mayo Clinic, Statewide w/o Mayo Clinic, Alliance & PimaConnect
- » PPO and qualified HDHP options
- » Companies can choose up to 4 plan options
- » Telemedicine offered with \$0 copay

## Metlife Insurance
