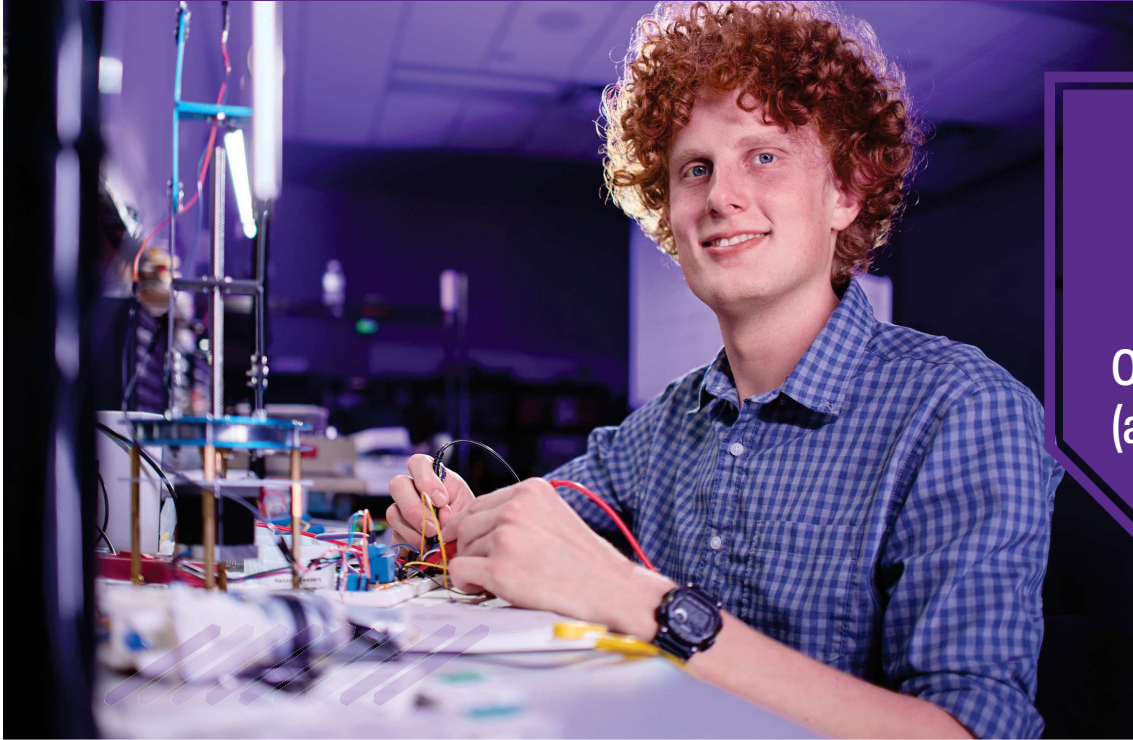

³ 26SMOUI0127: In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must be enrolled full-time in a ground traditional program at GCU and meet all GCU admissibility requirements. This scholarship is only awarded to eligible Arizona Technology Council participant employees, spouses or dependents who are enrolled in a ground traditional technology program or engineering program who are required to pay a program premium. Programs that do not incur a program premium charge are not eligible for this scholarship program.
